9. GENERAL MANAGER COMMENTS

GM Flood reported that we are at 87 %, two wells have gone artesian. We would need about another 31,000 AF to fill/spill. I provided a memo last year on the actions that we take as things get closer with notifications and when we shut off Robles. In 2005 we shut it off before we were at that point. Director Cole added we shut off Robles at two feet below spill.

State water project went from 10% - 15%. If there is a substantial snowpack increase this weekend, we should easily be at 50-60%.

We are working on the budget right now and plan to have a draft to committee in the next few months. It looks like extremely low consumption at maybe 8,500 acre feet. We will work on a number appropriate to project revenue for next year. There will only be a small amount of capital we will be able to do with such low water sales.

Covid reimbursement looks like \$65,000. We will protest that amount and will keep you updated. We have been working with FEMA regarding the storm damage from last year. We hope to see that finalized soon.

Director Brennan attended the Ventura Water Commission meeting. It is interesting and disconcerting to see how there is mistrust of staff and the numbers etc. Director Brennan also attended the Ventura Chamber legislation meeting where they discussed SB 1483 regarding groundwater.
